

Travel to the Manchester Congress

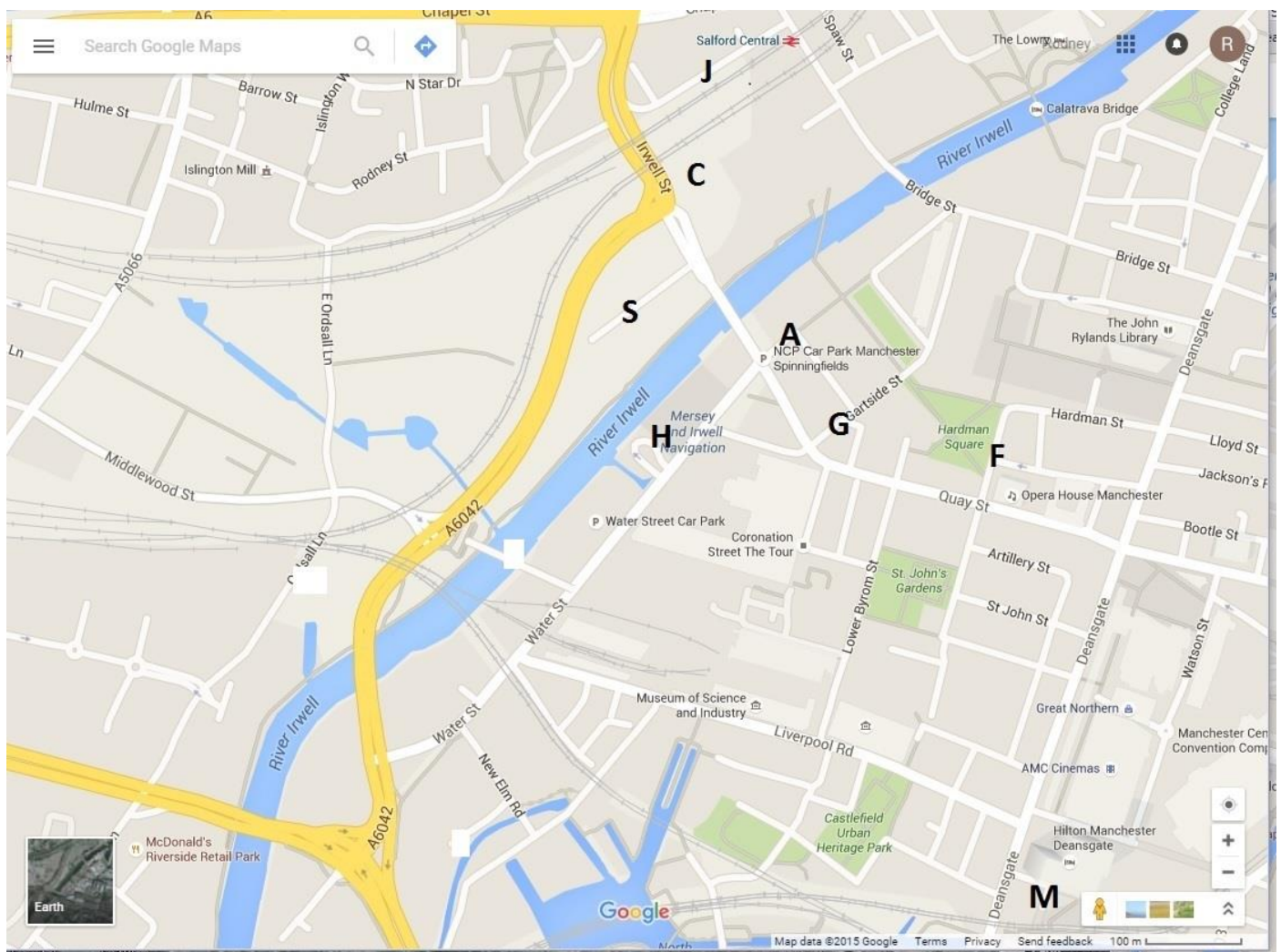
The venue is the Victoria and Albert Hotel on Water Street M3 4JQ in the Spinningfields area of the city centre. (H on the map). The hotel has a number of car parking spaces at ~£8 per day as well as a few disabled parking spaces.

There are two NCP car parks <http://www.ncp.co.uk/parking-solutions/cities/manchester> car park 30, the nearer on Water Street M3 3BE across New Quay Street (A on the map) which is £25 per day (maybe less if pre-booked), the further one is across the Irwell on Irwell Street M3 5AY <http://www.ncp.co.uk/find-a-car-park/car-parks/salford-new-bailey> (C on the map) which is also £25 per day (again maybe less if pre-booked).

The ground level car park on Gore Street Salford (J on map) is ~£3.50 and about 600 metres from the hotel.

Further down New Quay Street and across the Irwell parking on Stanley Street (S on map) on the left is free at the weekend, but there is only space for a few cars. This is about 400 metres from the hotel.

Car sharing is recommended.



Public Transport

The nearest metro station is at Deansgate-Castlefield (near M on map) which is about a 1 km walk from the hotel.

The metroshuttle buses are free around the city centre. The number 1 bus runs along Deansgate from where it is a shortish walk to the hotel. The number 2 bus goes nearer, stopping on Byrom Street (F on map from Piccadilly) or Gartside Street (G on map from Shudehill).
