
One of the Monastery series, but in this one the reader is given a quiz in the text, on the problem the monk is about to face.




3. **DOE, John:** THE BRIDGE MANUAL ILLUSTRATED.

"John Doe" was Francis Reginald Roe who, according to some sources, was a founder of Auction Bridge when stationed in India at the end of the 19th century. His book *Auction Bridge*, published in Allahabad in 1899, is one of the earliest book on the game.



London 2001 1st edition. 8vo 159pp Dec card covers. As new


There are 48 hands covering a fine range of situations, engagingly presented as though they occurred in a variety of locales in a year in the Bridge life of Martin Hoffman.

This is an exceptionally entertaining Bridge biography of Canada's greatest pair, focusing mainly on their heyday between 1960 and 1974.




8. **IRWIN, Florence:** THE COMPLETE AUCTION BRIDGE PLAYER.

Red cloth no dw, slight sunning to spine and small nick to the top




An interesting and mildly challenging collection of thirty-six *Bridge movies*, all taken from championship play.



12. **LAWRENCE, Mike:** PLAY A SWISS TEAMS OF FOUR WITH MIKE LAWRENCE. **£6.00***


Louisville, Kentucky 1998 8th printing (1st 1982). 8vo 99pp Dec card covers. As new

This is labeled 'Advanced' and covers a range of perhaps controversial topics, with the author's often original point of view. At the end there are 30 quizzes, with well-explained answers.




This is the fifth of the Griffin Club books, all of which are entertaining. If 1st editions are what you seek, please get in touch.

A pastiche of the famous Menagerie characters, using some of his previously unpublished columns – at least in book form. As enjoyable as the originals.




17. **PAYNE, R J (Dick):** BRIDGE: SINGLE DUMMY PROBLEMS.


This maintains the standard of the series, with more entertaining adventures of the card-playing monks of St Titus.

The beauty of this for UK readers is that it covers bidding over a weak NT. The author tries to clarify weaker or stronger two-suiters, as well as pinpointing the 5 card suit in a 5-4 overcall.






Fifty articles set in a rubber game between couples. The hands and analysis are sound. The dialogue between the characters may amuse or grate.


The book features three more rubbers with the characters introduced in *Why You Lose at Bridge*. The Bridge is very good, and Simon's writing style makes it enjoyable.


A collection of Gray's articles and thoughts organized and expanded by by Norman Squire. There are a number of excellent chapters.
